### NOTICE CONCERNING HEARING LOCATIONS

Effective May 1, 2009, MWCC Procedural Rule 6 was amended to provide that the Commission *"may designate one or more central locations within the territory of each Administrative Judge, other than the county where the injury occurred, which may be the location for all hearings to be conducted by the Administrative Judge assigned to the territory."*

The Commission, in consultation with its Administrative Judges, has designated three locations within each of the four current territories which will serve as the primary and central location for all motion and evidentiary hearings which are to be set, from and after June 1, 2009. A copy of the current territory map with these locations depicted is enclosed for your reference. From and after June 1, 2009, please choose the most convenient of these locations when scheduling hearings in each of these territories.

In the event there are special circumstances which may render the use of one of these locations impractical or unjust for other good cause, you may petition the Judge assigned to your case for permission to hear the case in the county where the injury occurred, or in some other county which is agreeable by the parties.
